### Day 1

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### Day 2

PRAY: Ask the Lord to teach you from His word and help you keep it. "You are good, and do good; teach me Your statutes. The proud have forged a lie against me, but I will keep Your precepts with my whole heart." Psalm 119:68,69

READ: John 9:13-25

WRITE:
In verses 20–25, compare and contrast the blind man's response and his parents' response to the Pharisees questioning them?
APPLY:
There may have been a time in your own life where fear prevented you from testifying to God's work in your life. Make it a daily prayer that the Holy Spirit would keep you ready and give you boldness to testify to God's works in your life. Take a moment and write about just one of those works He has done for which you can give glory to Him.
Day 3
PRAY: Ask the Lord to see the treasure of His word. "The law of Your mouth is better to me than thousands of coins of gold and silver." Psalm 119:72
READ: John 9:26–34
WRITE:
How does this man describe Jesus as he speaks to the Pharisees from the verses above?
APPLY:
Learning the Word is essential if we want to glorify God in this world. Because the Pharisees didn't like what the man said, they cast him out of the temple. Perhaps you or someone you know has been rejected because of their faith in Jesus. What do you learn from John 9 that would help you to encourage them?

READ:	John 9
