Day 1

Day 2

PRAY: Ask the Lord to open your heart to believe His word.

READ: John 14:1–14

WRITE:

2. Where does Jesus state He is going in verse 12? _____

3. How will we see Jesus' work continue on earth because He will go to His Father? (v. 12–14)

APPLY:

In verses 7–11, John addresses the topic of knowing God. Read Jeremiah 9:23-24 for added insight into the worth of the knowledge of God and what it affords us. Take time to apply these passages in John 14 and Jeremiah 9 to your life today. Here are a few questions to ask yourself: "Where am I today in my relationship with God?" _____

"How have I gotten to know the Father through getting to know Jesus through the book of John?"

Day 3

PRAY: Ask the Father to reveal truth today by His Spirit through His word.

READ: John 14:15–31
