Day 1

APPLY:

Galatians 6:22 tells us that “The fruit of the Spirit is love” In John 15:12–15, Jesus describes the greatest love. What does that practically look like in your life? _____

Take a moment to pray and ask the Holy Spirit to help you live this truth out.

Day 4

PRAY: Ask God to open your understanding from His word. Think back through what you have studied in John 15 this week and what has stood out the most to you.

READ: Review that same scripture again.

WRITE:

On an index card or note card, write out that scripture and place it before you today so that you can meditate on it.
