Becoming God’s Woman A study on the Titus 2 Woman

Becoming a Woman Who Honors God: “Reverent in Behavior”

Study Guide 1

This week we will be looking at our first attribute of a godly woman from Titus 2—a woman reverent in behavior (Titus 2:3). Esther was just that woman; she was reverent in her behavior and honored God in how she responded to the challenges before her. Begin with a prayer asking God for a greater understanding of who He is and to help you to honor Him in all your ways.

DAY 1

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:66. Pray as you open the word today that God will teach you good judgement and knowledge.

READ: Titus 2:1–5

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? How does verse 5 correlate our behavior with the reputation of the word of God and what role does our behavior play in the honor, reverence, and impact of God’s Word? Write it here. _____

APPLY:

To reverence God in your life means that you have set Him apart as Lord over all. From 1 Peter 3:15, what does this life look like practically to you?

But in your hearts set Christ apart [as holy—acknowledging Him, giving Him first place in your lives] as Lord. Always be ready to give a [logical] defense to anyone who asks you to account for the hope and confident assurance [elicited by faith] that is within you, yet [do it] with gentleness and respect. 1 Peter 3:15 AMP

DAY 2

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:77. Thank the Lord for His word and pray the instructions He gives you today will bring you delight.

READ: Titus 2:3–5

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

1. From 2 Corinthians 7:1, what is required for you to live this life of reverence? _____

2. Who does John 14:26 say is available to help you to live out this lifestyle? _____

DAY 3

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:81. Thank the Lord that there is hope found in His word.

READ: Esther 2:15–20

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

Esther is a perfect example of a Titus 2 woman who honors the Lord by her behavior. What was her reverent example in Esther 2:15, 20? How does this challenge your response to the authorities placed in your life? _____

DAY 4

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:88. Praise God for His steadfast love and ask the Holy Spirit to help you keep His testimonies.

READ: Esther 4:1–5:5

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

God allowed the circumstances in Esther’s life to put her in a place to save her people. What circumstances is God allowing in your life to accomplish His purposes? (for such a time as this)

DAY 5

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:89. Stop and thank the Lord that His word never changes. Pray that you will hold fast to His word and what you learn from it.

READ: Esther 7:1–8:6

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

Esther’s choices lead her to saving her people from annihilation. Like Esther, our choices matter. What insight regarding choices do you gain from the scriptures below?
