## Becoming God's Woman A study on the Titus 2 Woman

### Becoming a Woman of Impact: "Not Slanderers"

#### Study Guide 2

Titus teaches us that as women we have a great responsibility for how we use our words. We are specifically exhorted not to be "slanderers." Anna is a great example of a woman who used her mouth to honor God. She was called a prophetess and chose to speak the things of the Lord rather than use her tongue for evil. Anna was also a widow who made the decision to dedicate her life wholly to the Lord. As we get ready to learn about her this week pause and pray that her life will impact yours in a powerful way!

#### DAY 1

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:93. Pray that you will holdfast to God's word and His life-giving promises.

READ: Titus 2:3-5 and James 3:2-12

#### WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

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#### APPLY:

From the verses James 3:2-12, what do you learn that challenges you to guard your spoken words carefully? \_\_\_\_\_

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**DAY 2**

PRAY: Psalm 119:97. Declare to the Lord how much you love His word and the instructions you find in it for your life.

READ: Proverbs 6:16–19, Proverbs 25:11 and Proverbs 18:21

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

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APPLY:

Many women never consider the incredible impact their words can have. What do you learn from the proverbs above that will help you to choose your words wisely? \_\_\_\_\_

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**DAY 3**

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:101. Praise God that His word has the power to keep you from evil.

READ:

Luke 2:36–38

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

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APPLY:

Anna was a widow at a very young age. She could have chosen to complain and be bitter over her loss but instead she faithfully served the Lord. How are you choosing to handle your personal circumstances? What are your words revealing about yourself? \_\_\_\_\_

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**DAY 4**

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:103. Pray that as you read the word today that it will be to you “sweeter than honey”.

READ: 1 Peter 4:10-11 and Psalm 19:14

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

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APPLY:

In the midst of Anna’s heartache and long widowhood, she remained faithful and devoted to serving the Lord. She chose to use her voice and the gift God had given her as a prophetess to bless others. How are you being faithful to use the gifts God has given you? \_\_\_\_\_

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**DAY 5**

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:105. Take time to pray that God’s word will be a light to shine in your life and give you the direction you need.

READ: Luke 2:38 and Luke 4:18

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

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APPLY:

Anna is a great example of a woman who used her words to build the kingdom of God. How does 1 Corinthians 2:1–5 challenge you to also use your words further the good news of the Gospel?

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
