“Becoming a Woman of Worship” “Love Their Children”

Study Guide 6

Titus 2 reminds us that God has blessed moms with an incredible position of influence within their homes. Moms are exhorted to “love their children.” Some acts of love come naturally to a mom, but the kind of love that is self-sacrificing and reflects Jesus love for us must be taught. Not only do we learn this from the Word but also from older and more experienced moms who have walked with the Lord. Hannah could be considered one of these women who qualifies to teach us. In her desperation to be a mom she cried out to God for a son, promising to dedicate him back to forever be a servant of God. God granted Hannah’s request, and, true to her promise, she dedicated her son Samuel to the Lord. What a self-sacrificing model for us to follow in raising our children!

DAY 1

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:128. Pray today for discernment to know and hate every false way.

READ: Titus 2:3–5, 2 Corinthians 6:18 and John 1:12–13

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

Read 1 John 3:1–3. What does it mean to you to know that you are greatly loved by God and you belong to His forever family? _____

DAY 2

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:129. Begin today with a prayer of praise thanking the Lord for His wonderful word.

READ: Hebrews 12:7–11

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

What is the God-given responsibility of every parent in raising their children and loving them according to the following scriptures?

DAY 3

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:130. Thank God for His word and the light it sheds on your life. Now ask the Spirit to give you understanding of what you study today.

READ: 1 Samuel 1:1–28

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

Our children are only “lent” to us for a season because they ultimately belong to the Lord. Hannah was willing to surrender Samuel because she knew God had a call and a purpose for his life. What precious thing in your life is God asking you to surrender, and are you willing to do it? (See Proverbs 3:5–6)

DAY 4

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:131. Pray that you will long for God’s Word and the instruction He gives to you in it.

READ: 1 Samuel 1:27–28, James 5:16, and Philippians 4:6–7

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

It must have appeared to Hannah that God was silent and not hearing her prayer. Instead of becoming anxious, she pressed in even closer crying out in fervent prayer. How do you find yourself reacting when God seemingly is not hearing your desperate prayers? _____

DAY 5

PRAY: Psalm 119:133. Pray that as you read the Word today that God would use it to direct your steps and life choices.

READ: 1 Samuel 2:1–11

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

Hannah was also a woman of worship. She recognized that God was the source of her blessing and success of her son Samuel. Read her overflowing heart of praise in 1 Samuel 2:1–11; now consider her life an example. What has impacted you most that you can apply to your walk in becoming God’s woman and a woman of worship? _____
