Study Guide 11

This week we will study our final characteristic in Becoming God's Woman. You might be surprised to learn that this commandment in God's word comes to each of us. Not only is it a call for a married woman to obey her earthly husband, but also a call for all of us, of obedience to Christ as His betrothed bride, the church. Though counter-cultural today, this truth is God's perspective and word to us. It is that attitude of the heart which He claims is “hidden beauty” and that which pleases Him. God lists Sarah in His word as an example of unswerving commitment to her husband Abraham, as unto the Lord. As you seek to learn from her example, ask Him to help you practically apply this truth and rejoice that you are the bride of Christ!

DAY 1

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:4. “You have commanded us to keep Your precepts diligently.” Pray for a heart that desires to diligently keep God's word.

READ: Titus 2:3–5, Isaiah 54:5, Jeremiah 7:23, and Luke 6:46

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

In Christ, each believer has a very unique and special relationship with the Lord. From the scriptures above, describe that relationship. How does knowing that affect your behavior?

DAY 2

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:7. "I will praise You with uprightness of heart, when I learn Your righteous judgments." Pray and take time to praise the Lord for His word and the power it has to help you live as you should.

READ: Ephesians 5:22–33

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

What can we learn from the marriage relationship described in Ephesians 5 that will help us in our marriage or in our relationship with Christ? _____

DAY 3

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:10. "With my whole heart I have sought You; oh, let me not wander from Your commandments!" Pray that you will wholeheartedly seek to learn and obey God's word.

READ: Genesis 12:1–20

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

Although Sarah lived in a world of danger and confusion, she stood firm in her commitment to trust her husband and God. In what way does she challenge you to walk by faith and trust the outcome to God? _____

DAY 4

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:11. "Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You." Pray that you will wisely hide God's word in your heart as a safeguard against sin.

READ: 1 Peter 2:21-3:6

WRITE:

DAY 5

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:12. "Blessed are You, O Lord! Teach me Your statutes." Pray for a teachable heart to learn from the Bible today.

READ: Revelation 19:6-9
