There is no escaping the fact that the Bible is a book that tells us how to live. Specifically here in the book of Titus, we're being challenged on how to become women of God. We're learning that to be reverent in our behavior there are things we must do and things we must avoid. This week we'll focus on a behavior we want to avoid if our lives are to be fruitful and honor God. We will take a look at Mary Magdalene who was once held captive by seven demons and a slave to sin. Jesus rescued her out of this darkness and brought her into His marvelous light, and she became one of His most devoted followers. What a shining example of hope she is for us today!

DAY 1

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:111. Ask the Lord to help His word bring joy to your heart today.

READ: Titus 2:3 and Ephesians 5:18

WRITE:

APPLY:

Read Galatians 5:22–25. What work does the Spirit do in our life to make us fruitful or productive in God's kingdom? _____

DAY 2

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:112. Pray for a heart determined to keep God's word and obey all He speaks to your heart today.

READ: 1 Corinthians 6:12–20

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

A woman who desires to be fruitful and glorify God has choices to make regarding who or what will control her life. What can you apply from 1 Corinthians 6:12, 19–20 that will help you make God-honoring choices? _____

DAY 3

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:114. Thank God that His word is a refuge, a shield, and your source of hope.

READ: Luke 8:1–3 and John 8:31–36

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

Mary Magdalene was a woman whose life was once mastered and held captive by seven demons but Jesus transformed her! How can this transformation take place for any woman who desires to be set free according to the following verses?

DAY 4

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:115. Pray that you will be steadfast and determined to keep the word of God.

READ: Mark 15:40–41 and John 20:11–18
