“Becoming a Woman of Devotion” “Chaste”

For weeks now we have been faced with the challenge of “Becoming God’s Woman.” And once again in this lesson we’ll explore another character trait that will lead us toward that end goal. We’ll be looking at what it means to be “chaste” or pure. Purity is the quality of being faultless or uncompromised in our thought life, our words and our actions. As we look to the Word of God we find that Ruth is one such woman. We can look at her and model our behavior after her chaste example.

DAY 1

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:143. Pray for the determination to remain steadfast in your walk and to delight in the commands of the Lord.

READ: Titus 2:3–5, Psalm 24:3–4, Matthew 5:8

WRITE:

APPLY:

Chaste or pure behavior involves every area of our life and is an essential character quality for anyone desiring to become God’s woman. Share what you learn regarding the value of purity from the scriptures above? _____

DAY 2

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:144. Pray. Do you want to understand God’s Word? That ask Him for understanding!

READ: 1 Thessalonians 4:7, 1 Timothy 2:8–10 and 2 Timothy 2:20–22

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

What does walking in purity require of you on a daily basis? _____

DAY 3

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:145. Start today with prayer crying out for the will to keep the commands of the Lord

READ: Ruth 1:14–17 and Ruth 2:11–12

WRITE:

After reading this passage of scripture, what did the Spirit speak to your heart? Write it here.

APPLY:

Ruth made a life changing decision to follow the one true God and leave behind her lifestyle of idol worship. We face the same challenge today to steer clear of idolatry and walk in purity and devotion to the Lord. How does Ruth’s commitment challenge you to live? (See also 2 Corinthians 11:2–3 NLT)

DAY 4

PRAY: Read Psalm 119:147. Pray. Thank God that His Word brings you hope day by day.

READ: Ruth 3:1–11

APPLY:

Purity is a lifestyle choice. What is the result of walking in purity from Ruth’s example? _____
